She received her magisterium and doctorate from the Faculty of Economics of the University of Belgrade. The focus of her research interests are the following areas: entrepreneurship, business process management and quality management. During her scientific research career, she published more than 150 scientific papers, two textbooks and six monographs.

She participates or has participated in the realization of a number of domestic and international projects (Erasmus+). She is currently managing a Horizon Europe project. She coordinated one cross-border cooperation

project with Bulgaria (IPA framework), as well as projects whose realization was financed by the Ministry of Education, Science and Technological Development of the Republic of Serbia (program activity: Development of higher education), the City of Niš and the Office for Local Economic Development and Projects of the City of Niš.

She was vice-dean for science at the Faculty of Economics in Niš, she managed the Center for Economic Research and was the chief and responsible editor of the journal Economic Topics (2015-2018).

As a scholarship recipient of the Austrian Ministry of Science and Research, she was a visiting researcher on three occasions at the University of Economics and Business in Vienna (2004, 2009 and 2011). She spent the summer semester as a guest lecturer and researcher at the Willamette University, Atkinson Graduate School of Management, Oregon, USA within the Junior Faculty Development program (2013). Within the academic mobility programs, she visited the following universities: Middlesex University in London (2018), D.A. Tsenov Academy of Economics, Svishtov, Bulgaria (2018) and Akdeniz University in Antalya, Turkey (2015).
